



Plan of STEAM lesson

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Class 9

Topic of the lesson	Briefly about Ludwig van Beethoven
Purpose of the lesson	To review the most important aspects of Beethoven's life and work, for the purpose to expand the knowledge of the German language, to improve pronunciation, to introduce and consolidate a specific vocabulary.
Didactic goal	To show the benefits of foreign language skills in various fields, to stimulate interest in the most famous composers of all time and their native language.
Real problem / problematic situation	Various events are organized around the world to mark the 250th anniversary of Beethoven's birth. The integrated lesson in German and music provides an opportunity to speak the native language of the composer about the historical, geographical context, listen to the most famous works and discuss their uniqueness, thus better remembering information about one of the most famous composers. The lesson emphasizes and consolidates the knowledge about numbers, compound words, verb tenses and prepositions that were learned during German lessons.

Critical thinking development	The tasks are presented to the students in as many different ways as possible, but with a strong emphasis on logical thinking, interfaces and sense of language (looking for links between the German words "joy" and "friends"; laying out the main motive of "Ode to Joy" from coffee beans, because Beethoven was very fond of coffee and had a very strict discipline; laying out the puzzles for the most famous works) by sharing their opinions with the help of app menti.com.
Integrated subjects	Music, German language
Expected result	In an effort to emphasize positivity and intrigue created by learning, students will deepen their knowledge of German in terms of numbers, musical and geographical terms, relating everything to the contexts of life and work of one of the most famous composers. This topic will be continued in subsequent German language and music lessons (translating a detailed agenda, analyzing music, etc.).
